10 – 17 June 2017, Cascais, Portugal – Brest, France

The SAIL for Teachers was carried out on board the sailing ship “Fryderyk Chopin” during one week sailing on the North Sea, starting from Cascais, Portugal, ending in Brest, France. The aim was to enhance understanding of sustainability issues in global and local perspective, train teaching and learning methods, give skills for working in multidisciplinary international environment and support teambuilding capabilities for university teachers.

The academic programme included lectures, workshops, presentations and discussions on sustainability issues on thematic areas. The course gave an overview of the current situation concerning some of the most important issues of education for sustainable development in higher education, learning and teaching methods. The participants contributed with their own expertise and each participant presented their contribution as a part of a thematic working group. The participants represented different disciplines supporting multi- and interdisciplinary approach. International working groups and three sailing group watches, promoted multicultural teambuilding. The participants represented 23 universities from 12 countries.
