Requirements for conference proceedings: Length of abstracts: 2-4 full pages (together with sources used) in A5 format, MS Word (.doc/.docx). Times New Roman font, 10 point font size, 1.0 spacing. Paragraph indentation -1.0 cm. Margins: left, top and bottom -2.0 cm, right -1.0 cm.

Information about the author - name, position, place of work (study), e-mail.

Graphical materials must be grouped and embedded in the text. Each table, illustration, diagram, scheme should be signed and have a title. The source should be indicated below the tables and figures.

Formulas should be typed using the Microsoft Equation editor and numbered in parentheses on the right side.

The list of references should contain only sources that are referenced in the text.

An example of how to cite references: (Petrenko et al., 2020). Parenthetical references to different sources should be separated by semicolons: (Petrenko et al., 2020; Hassan et al., 2014).

The list of references is drawn up according to the international bibliographic standard of the APA (American Psychological Association).
